Readers challenged to:

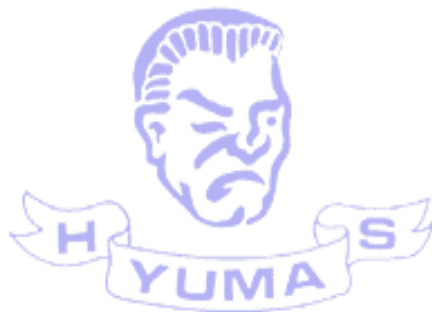
1. Read a book about a character who doesn't look like you or live like you

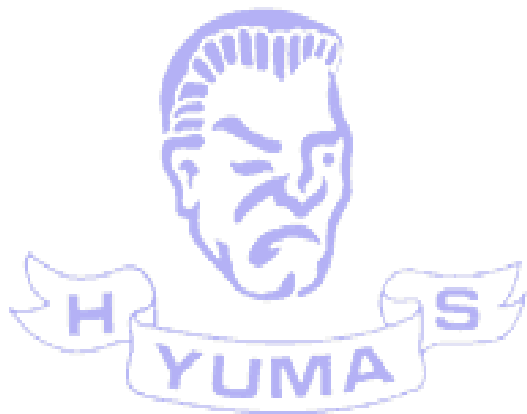
